

Japanese company NIHON PARKERIZING (INDIA) has allocated funds from its 2023 CSR budget to support activities of the Gurgaon-based NGO WeCare Foundation, through an introduction by the Musubi-Te Foundation. A site visit was conducted to observe the initiatives firsthand.

1. Ms. Pallavi, the representative of WeCare Foundation, explained the NGO

Ms. Pallavi, the representative of WeCare Foundation, shared the background of the NGO's inception, which was inspired by her encounters with children who were not eating daily. The foundation now ensures that every student receives at least one meal a day. The NGO's goal is to reintegrate children who are not attending school back into formal education, providing educational opportunities to approximately 200 children. Previously, Ms. Pallavi worked in a telecommunications company but decided to leave her job to fully commit to the NGO's activities.

3. Performances and a donation of shoes.

Children showcased a dance performance, and shoes prepared in advance were donated to coincide with the start of the new school year.



4. Facility Tour

Ms. Pallavi, the representative of WeCare Foundation, provided a tour of the facility. The tour included visits to the computer class, library, and kitchen. She also guided through the classrooms and informed about the initiation of vocational training programs, which included several sewing machines.

2. Mr. Wakabayashi, the representative of NIHON PARKERIZING (INDIA) PVT. LTD, introduced the company and delivered a message to the children.

Mr. Wakabayashi from NIHON PARKERIZING (INDIA) PVT. LTD spoke to the children in an approachable manner, explaining that their company manufactures chemicals that protect car bodies from rust. He encouraged the children to study hard and expressed his hope that one day they might work for his company. Additionally, he engaged the children by asking about their impressions of Japan, creating a friendly and inviting atmosphere.



In the future, activity reports will be shared, and plans are being made to arrange visits for the children of WeCare Foundation to the Gurgaon office and the Neemrana factory. Additionally, introductions to other activity locations of the NGO will be included. Under the support provided, children who are unable to receive basic education will continue their studies daily and work towards securing employment in the future. A continuous relationship will be established among the three organizations to support these activities.
